**APPLY NOW**

A total of 120 credits with a 2.0 grade point average is required for graduation. Many of these hours you may have already completed in your previous education, and they can be transferred to Ohio University; some will be earned while taking nursing courses and support courses. After University admittance, a review of your previous coursework will result in a DARS report (Degree Audit Reporting System), which illustrates what is needed to complete your BSN.

## Nursing Courses

Nine nursing courses (NRSE) will be completed online from Ohio University for 31 credit hours total. All nursing courses are offered in five week sessions.

- Associate degree or diploma in nursing
- Grade point average of 2.0 or higher
- Completed online application (including NCLEX-RN date/location, if not yet licensed, in order to be reviewed for admission)
- Earned the transferable equivalent of ENG 1510 Freshman Composition (If you have not completed the equivalent of Freshman Composition, you must complete the course within six months of admission)
- Resident with an active unencumbered RN license of Ohio, Arizona, California, Connecticut, Delaware, Florida, Illinois, Indiana, Kansas, Kentucky, Michigan, Minnesota, Montana, New Jersey, New York, North Carolina, Nevada, Oregon, Pennsylvania, South Carolina, Texas, Virginia, West Virginia or Washington, D.C.
