




Dual Enrollment Access Gap Tool


High School vs. Dual Enrollment Representation by Ethnicity

Fall 2024


- **922** high school students enrolled in NVC classes
- **26 CCAP** classes offered
- **Early College Program** at New Technology HS launched in August



LOCAL UPDATES



Spring 2025

- **650** high school students expected to enroll
- **22 CCAP** classes will be scheduled
- **Special Permit to Attend**
 - Students who have completed a CCAP or Non-CCAP permit to register for Summer 2024 or Fall 2024 classes will be exempt from completing a new permit to register for Spring 2025 classes.



DUAL ENROLLMENT FACULTY


- HS alignment with **college minimum qualifications** to teach in specific disciplines

- Funds to support **CCAP faculty professional development**


